(To exchange "a son" for "firstborn" perpetuates the Roman Catholic doctrine that Mary was a perpetual virgin and had no other children than Jesus which is false as the Bible openly refutes this heresy - Matt. 12:46; 13:55; Mark 3:31, 6:3; John 2:12; 7:3,5; 1 Cor. 9:5; Gal. 1:19)
Matthew 8:29 KJV: And behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of God? art thou come hither to torment us before the time?	RSV: And behold, they cried out, "What have you to do with us, O Son of God? Have you come here to torment us before the time?"	Removed Jesus name before son of God

But Jesus said to them again, "Children, how hard it is[a] to enter the kingdom of God!	Takes away the lesson about rich men and implies salvation is difficult
Mark 11:10 KJV: Blessed be the kingdom of our father David, that cometh in the name of the Lord: Hosanna in the highest.	RSV: Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that is coming! Hosanna in the highest!"	
Luke 2:33 KJV: And Joseph and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him.	RSV: And his father and his mother marveled at what was said about him;	Imply that Joseph was the father of Jesus
Luke 4:4 KJV: And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.	RSV: And Jesus answered him, "It is written, `Man shall not live by bread alone.'"	Removes the requirement follow the Bible
