

Ekal Tailoring Training Center



Tailoring Training is an initiative to empower rural women through micro-entrepreneurship. We teach women how to sew clothes and connect them to large-scale market opportunities, increasing both earning potential and self-confidence.

How it Works

The center is established in a cluster of 30 villages. Women from the villages are provided with a 3 month training program on basic sewing skills. At the end of the course, they can sew blouses, dresses, pajamas, petticoats etc.

What happens when they graduate?

- Start their small tailoring shop in their own village and earn from 2-5000Rs/month
- Start a satellite tailoring training center in their village.
- Form Self-Help-Groups to work on large contracts

How much does it cost to support a center?

A one-time donation of \$30,000 helps the run the center for 3 years. We hope to make it self-sustaining after the 3 years with local support
