

# Blended Learning Contract

## **Credit Earned:**

I understand that I only get credit for the classes I complete and pass. You do not get credit for sitting in a chair in this classroom. You can ONLY get credit for completed and passed courses.

## **Personal Responsibility:**

You will be held responsible only for the things YOU do or fail to do. What others choose to do or not do is of little importance in determining whether or not you have accepted your responsibility as a student of Woodland Park High School. The decision will be yours, and so will be the consequences. Your first responsibility is to decide how you should conduct yourself while you are in this class. Your second responsibility is to be prepared to accept the consequences of your actions.

Students are expected to use appropriate language at all times. Directing profanity, vulgar language, or obscene gestures toward other students, school personnel, or visitors to the school will not be tolerated.

Tardiness is the appearance of a student without proper excuse after the bell rings or the scheduled time that a class begins. Almost all tardiness, except that caused by school bus transportation problems, is avoidable. Parents shall convey any extenuating circumstances to the administration or office personnel to determine if the tardy will be excused.

## **Cell Phones:**

Cell Phones should not take away from learning and work completion. Students are expected to self-manage their behavior. If your phone is out when it is not supposed to be, you will be asked to place it on Ms. Becker, Ms. Roberts or Ms. Crisp's desk until the end of class.
