## To be completed! Including future work time

Create a google slide presentation. This should cover more than one slide. Be sure to include in this presentation the information below.

- At least one picture of the artwork.
- Name of the artist, title of the artwork, and the date (if possible)
- Background information on the artist, as appropriate (I don't want a biography)
- Topic of the painting (Religious? Secular? Mythological? Portrait?)

- Detailed description of the painting (What do you see? What colors are used? What techniques are used? Is there perspective? Shading? Is it realistic? Etc.)
- Analysis of what <u>you</u> think the painting means and what it reveals about the artist, the topic, or the Renaissance.
- Personal reaction to the painting (Do you like the painting? Why/Why Not?)
- One other reaction to your artwork, can be parent, sibling, friend, or anyone who is willing to take a look.
- Be sure to share your google slide so I can view this (change your setting to anyone with the link can view).
