## **Sentio Supervision Model**

Step 1. Opening Supervision	
	Check in on previously assigned DP homework.  Check supervisee's outcome data.
	cheek supervisee's outcome data.
Step 2. Ask supervisee to share and read the Supervision Preparation Form	
	Optionally, ask for any additional information you deem relevant.  Watch a therapy recording segment chosen by the trainee.
Step 3. Identify Client Challenge	
	1. "Notice that your client is saying/doing" 2. "What I think might be happening here is [theoretical formulation]"
Step 4. Identify Therapist Deficit	
	1. "When your client does [challenge], notice that you do [deficit]" 2. (Optional) "What was your intention (desired outcome) behind this intervention?"
	3. (Optional) "How did the client react to your intervention?" 4. "This intervention might be keeping you stuck because [rationale]"
Step 5. Identify Learning Goal	
	1. "How about we practice [skill / supervisor models intervention]?" 2. "This might help here because [rationale]"
Step 6. Behavioral Rehearsal w/ feedback	
	1. "[Positive feedback]. I think you could [corrective feedback]." 2. "Let's try that again."
Step 7. Assign DP Homework & Feedback	
í	'Use the same therapy recording segment to repeat the same exercise for at least 10-minutes until our next supervision session."  Optionally, suggest additional conceptual readings or resources.



## **Suggested Supervision Timeline:**

- Minutes 1-5: Step 1: Opening Supervision
- Minutes 5-10: Step 2: Supervision Preparation Form
- Minutes 10-25: Steps 3-5: Identify a Challenge, Deficit & Learning Goal
- Minutes 25-48: Step 6: Behavioral rehearsal
- Minutes 48-50: Step 7: Assign DP Homework

## When to revert to traditional supervision:

- Trainee is sick or dysregulated.
- Trainee presents case management needs for severe/complex clients. (e.g. management of psychotic episode; complex legal/ethical issues)
- There is an indication of rupture in the supervisory relationship.
