

## Lesson Plan Idea Format

**Grade Level & Subject Area: Language Arts: Handwriting**

Kids have already learned each letter in print and cursive

Students already have been taught the print letters and cursive. This is review

**Objective (What are the students' going to accomplish):**

Students will be able to write each letter in cursive

**Materials:**

iPads, Smartboard to show video, [video link](#), app "iTrace-Handwriting for kids", Apple Pencils

**Procedure:**

Intro:

- Students watch the video on the Smart board and they copy the letters onto a piece of paper to reintroduce each letter to their eyes and hands

Instruction:

- Students get on the app iTrace and practice cursive writing for the remaining of the time

Closure:

- Students write each letter on a piece of paper A-Z without any help

**Assessment (How will the students' show you that the objective has been met):**

Students are assessed by turning in their A-Z cursive sheet. Assessment is based on accuracy as well as penmanship. This is a summative assessment.

**A Brief Description Of The Entire Lesson - Plus Any Additional Information to be Included:**

Students watch a video and interact with the video by doing as he man in the video is doing. They then practice cursive writing with the app "iTrace." Then, they take a summative assessment by writing each letter on a piece of paper in cursive.
