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Introduction

This template should be used as a guide to the format and or layout of writing articles that will be published in the International Journal Multidisciplinary. Authors must follow all writing rules, both in terms of font, size, layout, word count, systematics, and reference writing. The author must also ensure that the article uses good and correct Indonesian language.

The body of the article including the bibliography is written in one column as in this template. Each new paragraph should be written indented into a single tab. Articles should be submitted in Microsoft Word, with A4 paper size, 2.54 cm top and left margins, 2.54 cm right and bottom margins, and single spacing between lines. The font used in the body of the article is (Book Antiqua (Body), Font Size 11).

The writing of punctuation marks (period, comma, colon, semicolon, parentheses, quotation marks, question marks, exclamation marks, slashes, etc.) is not preceded by a space and is continued by a space, except for the use of periods or commas in decimal number markers. Examples of the use of this section can be seen throughout the content of this template.

The introduction section mainly contains the reasons for conducting the research supported by a literature (theoretical) review. The introduction is expected to contain as many citations as possible from scientific journals (preferably from national journals and reputable international journals).

To facilitate the author, technically the author can use this template in full. The author can adjust the entire content of the writing with this template (overwritten) section by section, so that as a whole it is expected that the submitted article is in accordance with the expected guidelines. We recommend deleting as needed, to avoid errors in other parts..

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Methods

The research method used in solving the problem includes an analytical method. Figure captions should be part of the figure caption, not part of the figure. The methods

used in the completion of the research are written in this section. In the Research Methods, small and non-main tools (already common in the lab, such as: scissors, measuring cups, pencils) do not need to be written down, but simply write down the main set of equipment only, or the main tools used for analysis and / or characterization, even need to go to type and accuracy; Write in full the location of the research, the number of respondents, how to process the results of observations or interviews or questionnaires, how to measure performance benchmarks; common methods do not need to be written in detail, but simply refer to the reference book. Experimental procedures should be written in the form of news sentences, not command sentences.

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Results and Discussion

Results and discussion contain the results of research findings and their scientific discussion. Write down scientific findings obtained from the results of the research that has been carried out but must be supported by adequate data. The scientific findings referred to here are not the data obtained from the research. The scientific findings must be explained scientifically including: What are the scientific findings obtained? Why did it happen? Why is the variable trend like that? All these questions must be explained scientifically, not just descriptively, if necessary supported by adequate basic scientific phenomena. In addition, it must also be explained in comparison with the results of other researchers with similar topics. The research results and findings must be able to answer the research hypothesis in the introduction.

Manuscripts can be written in Indonesian or English with a maximum of 20 pages including figures and tables. Manuscripts must be written according to this article template in camera ready form. The article must be written in A4 size (210 x 297 mm) and with a format of 3 cm left margin, 3 cm right margin, 3 cm bottom margin, and 3 cm top margin. The manuscript must be written in Times New Roman typeface with a font size of 12 pt, single-spaced, and in a one-column format (except for the article title, author name, and abstract). The distance between columns is 1 cm.

Foreign words or terms are italicized. It is best to avoid using foreign terms for Indonesian-language articles. A new paragraph starts 1.15 cm from the left margin, while there is no space between paragraphs.

Tables and Figures are placed in the text group after the table or figure is referred to. Each figure should be given a Figure Caption at the bottom of the figure and numbered in numerical sequence followed by the title of the figure. Each table must be given a table caption and numbered sequentially at the top of the table followed by the table title. Figures must be guaranteed to print clearly (font size, resolution and line size must be guaranteed to print clearly). Figures and tables and diagrams/schematics should be placed in columns between groups of text or, if too large, in the center of the page. Tables should not contain vertical lines, while horizontal lines are allowed but only important ones.

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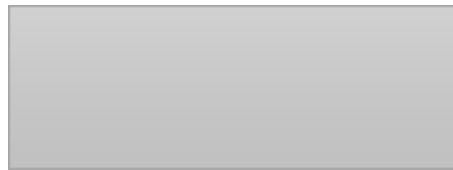


Figure 1. Mendeley Standard View

The use of tables and figures should be mentioned in the text by mentioning table 1; figure 1 and so on.
