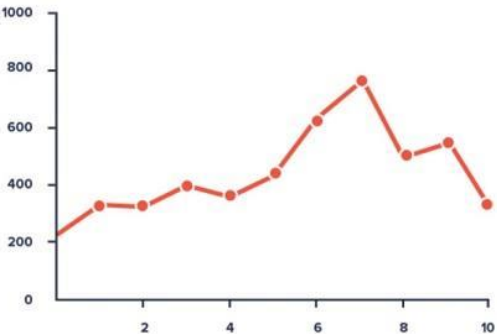


Figure 1. Graph of Mean Aggressiveness of Experimental in the Initial and Final Tests (Font 12 pt)
