

## **GLIDE GARDEN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS AND APPLICATION FORM**

The Glide Garden Club sponsors a \$500 scholarship for a qualifying Glide High School graduating senior who plans to attend Umpqua Community College in the fall of the year in which he or she graduates. The scholarship is designated specifically for the purchase of textbooks over the course of the school year and may include the purchase of supplies as required by instructors.

The student may enroll in any of the two-year degree programs, including pursuit of a vocational career or trade offered at U.C.C. If the student intends to attend U.C.C. for a second year, he or she may again apply (along with the spring pool of applicants from G.H.S.) for the Glide Garden Club Scholarship the following spring by contacting the club (P.O. Box 681, Glide, OR 97443) by the first Monday in March.

### **Follow the instructions below carefully.**

1. Fully answer all the questions on the application form.
2. Provide an official Glide High School transcript.
3. Submit three letters of reference. Two must come from G.H.S. teachers, one of which teaches a required class during the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of your senior year. The third reference can be one of your choosing, which may include another teacher. The letters are confidential and will not be shared with you. Ask your references to seal their letters in envelopes and label them *Glide Garden Club Scholarship* along with their signatures and then give them to you.
4. Written Essay-- discuss the following points in an interesting, well-organized, type-written essay
  - your plans for your future
  - your chosen field of study and the reasons for your choice
  - experiences you have had that have helped lead you to this decision
  - why you feel this career is right for you
  - the personal goals it will help you to fulfill
  - how the experiences you have had and classes you have taken in high school have prepared you for the challenge of college
5. Submit all the above material in a large envelope packet to your high school counselor no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>.
