Hartland Kids Day 2026 In-Person Event

General Liability and Communicable Disease Notice, Waiver, and Assumption of Risk

Participation in or attendance at the Hartland Kids Day event ("Event") constitutes agreement to the following terms.

1. General Release and Assumption of Risk

By attending or participating in the Event, each guest ("Guest") acknowledges and assumes all risks associated with participation in the Event and activities connected to it.

Guests agree that LCFF, LLC (Lake Country Family Fun), the Event hosts, sponsors, vendors, volunteers, and any of their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, members, employees, agents, insurers, representatives, successors, and assigns (collectively, the "Released Parties") shall not be liable for any injuries, illnesses, losses, damages, or claims arising out of or related to attendance at or participation in the Event.

This includes, but is not limited to, claims relating to:

- Personal injury
- Illness
- Property damage
- Accidents related to activities or equipment
- Contact with other participants or attendees

Attendance at and participation in the Event is voluntary, and all Guests assume the inherent risks associated with community events and outdoor activities.

2. Communicable Disease Acknowledgment

Guests acknowledge that attendance at public gatherings carries a risk of exposure to communicable diseases, including but not limited to COVID-19, influenza, RSV, and other viral or bacterial illnesses.

By attending the Event, Guests understand that:

- Exposure to illness may occur in any public setting where people are present.
- The Released Parties cannot guarantee that guests will not be exposed to or contract any illness.
- Attendance at the Event is voluntary and at each Guest's own risk.

Guests voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to communicable diseases while attending or participating in the Event.

3. Release of Claims

By attending the Event, Guests agree to release and hold harmless the Released Parties from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, losses, or expenses arising out of or related to participation in or attendance at the Event, including claims related to illness, injury, property damage, or death, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

4. Indemnification

Guests agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from any claims, liabilities, damages, losses, or expenses arising from their participation in the Event or their actions while attending the Event.

5. Severability

If any portion of this notice or agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

6. Agreement Through Attendance

By attending or participating in Hartland Kids Day, Guests acknowledge that they have read, understand, and agree to the terms of this liability waiver and assumption of risk.

7. Photography and Media Release

Hartland Kids Day is a public community event where photographs, video recordings, and other media may be captured.

By attending or participating in the Event, guests grant permission to LCFF, LLC (Lake Country Family Fun), event organizers, sponsors, and affiliated partners to photograph, film, record, and otherwise capture their image, likeness, voice, or participation during the Event.

Guests acknowledge and agree that such photos, videos, and recordings may be used for lawful purposes including, but not limited to:

- Event promotion
- Social media posts
- Websites
- Marketing materials
- News coverage
- Future event promotion

Guests understand that these materials may be used without compensation and may appear in print, digital, or broadcast formats.

Guests waive any right to inspect or approve the finished materials and release the event organizers and affiliated parties from any claims related to the use of such media.

Parents or guardians attending with minors acknowledge and agree that this release applies to the minors accompanying them.

If a parent or guardian does not wish for their child to appear in photographs used for promotional purposes, they should notify an event organizer at the event.
