



Post-Secondary Timeline

Semester One

Ⓟ Meet your counselor - You may be assigned to a new counselor in 10th grade. Be sure to stop by the guidance office and meet her -

Mrs. Cantymagli: Last Names A-L

Mrs. Mellinger: Last Names M-Z

- Ⓟ Check your email: Weekly emails will continue coming to you regarding guidance updates and announcements, college visits, scholarships and other important post-secondary planning information.
- Ⓟ Sign up for the PSAT: You can sign up for the PSAT as a sophomore to help pre-prepare you for the SATs. The PSAT is administered in October. Nationally, it is only administered currently.
- Ⓟ Take on Leadership positions: Whether it be in a school club, on the athletics field, or with a church youth group – taking on leadership roles will show post-secondary institutions that are well-rounded, outgoing, and responsible
- Ⓟ Tour and apply to CTC: ½ day CTC applications for your junior year will be available in the second quarter and will be due before you leave for winter break.

Semester Two

- Ⓟ Enter your course requests in PowerSchool before the deadline: Discuss possible course selection choices with your teachers and family. Make sure the courses you select are relevant to your post-secondary plans.
- Ⓟ Begin to familiarize yourself with the college application process: Visit College Board and Naviance to begin to understand the process of applying to schools.
- Ⓟ Read and write: Hone your reading and writing skills to help prepare you for the SAT exams.
