

How to Get a Good Grade in Math Class

- Students need a two pocket folder, a notebook, and a calculator for math class all year. Please replace them if needed.
- Students are responsible for checking Google Classroom **every Sunday** to copy the plans for the week in their planner and the notes for the next day's lesson in their notebook.
- Students are responsible to check Google classroom **nightly** to copy notes and/or to watch videos to prepare for the next day's lesson.
- Students will take notes on key vocabulary, key concepts and examples completed in class to use with homework at home and to study for tests.
- Students must **SHOW ALL THEIR WORK** on homework in pencil or they will receive a **50%** with the opportunity to redo it for a better grade.
- Students may **redo all homework assignments for a better grade**. They must **SHOW ALL THEIR WORK** when correcting errors on homework papers in blue ink (or other colored pen) so I can easily find the new work. Just writing in the correct answer does NOT qualify as redo work. They can do this work on their own, with the help of Mrs. Marnatti at 7:20 in the morning, or during Study Hall to receive an average of the two scores for a better grade.
- All corrections and absent work must be turned in by the end of the chapter test.
- **No redo work** on Simple Solutions assignments.
- 30 minutes of Recommended IXL Math Skills **due every Friday** unless otherwise specified on GC. Grades are based on the number of minutes completed.
- Chapter IXL assignments will be assigned for every chapter. Students have **one week** after the chapter test to earn the highest grade possible to be recorded on FACTS.
- Students may come in at 7:20 in the morning for math help if needed. This time is to be used for a specific question or section of the homework assignment and NOT intended to complete the whole assignment.
- All papers from the current chapter should remain in the math folder until the end of the chapter test when they should be taken home and filed accordingly for future exams.
