What is Revising & Editing?

"Revising & Editing" is the third stage in the Writing Process. When you revise, you

- review and improve the order of ideas, add detail to "Show, don't Tell",
- choose the best words, and
- create sentence variety.

When you edit, you

correct spelling, punctuation,
 capitalization, line spaces, margins,
 font size, and other formatting.


Revising & Editing are two separate things.

Revising is improving. Editing is correcting. But you can go back and forth between each process to improve your draft.

Why? Revising & Editing are a "team" - they work with you to improve your writing so it can be your personal best. This process uses a special checklist called a **flowchart**.

Each task in this stage of the Writing Process takes time.

- The first part of the flowchart, takes 1 study session.
- The second part of the flowchart takes about 1-2 study sessions, and
- The last part takes 1 study session.


