Commit to Meets

All swimmers need to “commit” or notify their attendance to Time Trials and all meets. Once this window is open, please go to the website to submit your response for each swimmer for each meet. The directions are as follows.

1. Log into the website and go to “Team Events.”
2. Select the meet and go to “**Edit Commitment**”
3. Select your child’s name.
4. In the next window, make a choice under ***Declaration**, then hit “Save Changes.”

For “B” meets **only**, please include 2 individual events that your child wants to swim. Note this cannot be an event that they have qualified in Tri-County.

Volunteer Positions

Ann Harrington is our volunteer coordinator. We have an amazing team and are lucky to have many families who volunteer their time to ensure the success of our team. Volunteer signups will be emailed as well as accessible on the team website under each meet. Some positions are only for home meets. The following is a description of each position.

Stagers (Both): Stagers are responsible for organizing swimmers in the area behind the starting blocks keeping them in the right lane for the right event and right order for relays. They ensure that at least 3 heats are prepared prior to each race.

Timers (Both): Timers are responsible for taking swimmer's times. There are 3 per lane in A meets and 2 in B meets. Please circle the middle times for A meets. You will be supplied with a stopwatch.

Runners (Home): Runners are responsible for picking up the recorded times from the 6 timers and 2 place judges and delivering them to the scoring table.

Ribbons (Both): Ribbon volunteers take the printed labels/results from the printer and affix them to the appropriate ribbon. Each ribbon is then placed in the folder/box in alphabetical order.

Set Up and Take Down: This group is responsible for setting up the big tent where our swimmers sit in home meet. On away meets, we bring a portable tent that requires set up and take down as well.

Cherry Bowl is the annual championship meet for all 12 swim clubs of Cherry Hill. Roughly 800 swimmers participate each year with each club dressed in team themed costumes and entering the pool deck to music. Despite the limited number of swimmers participating, all swimmers are encouraged to attend. Cherry Bowl is free to swimmers. There is an entrance fee for adults. This event typically lasts all day until 4PM. Please keep this in mind for young siblings.

Tri-County Championship is the season end championship swim meet for swimmers with qualifying times in individual events as well as our top relays in each age group. The Tri-County League consists of 33 swim clubs in Camden, Burlington, and Gloucester County with over 3000 swimmers participating. This meet spans 2 days. The first day is preliminary with the fastest 12 individual and relay times advancing to the finals on Sunday, August 3rd.

Our Tri-county swimmers are celebrated with breakfast the Friday before, as well as a bag of snacks and T shirt for the weekend. To ensure your child receives their T shirts in time, please make sure you commit to this event by July 20nd.
