The Virtual Office committee met on Monday 7-8pm on Zoom. We had two new attendees.

One person is interested in webmaster. We did an hour of training this Monday during the committee meeting and I met with them for two hours on Thursday for more training. (Another person may be interested in doing a part of the job and attended both Monday & Thursday as well)

The potential webmaster will decide in about a week if they are officially doing it. They want to remain anonymous.

If they take the position, it would be for two hours of work per month for a total of \$50 per month (the amount we voted to approve in the budget during the Jan meeting.)

A third person contacted me yesterday 2/10/23 (Friday) and wants to learn more about the job to see if they want to do it. Emotionally and time boundary-wise, I already gave all I can this week to the webmaster training. So I didn't jump into training them, but instead will wait to see if the person I already started training says yes.

The 3rd person said to contact them if the potential webmaster says no. Also, they said they'll attend next month's committee meeting to ask questions and feel out the vibe.

We held our first Safety Exploration Ad Hoc committee meeting on Thursday 1/26/23 from 7-8pm via Zoom. 5 of 6 members could attend, one had to leave early and one come late.

We talked about Committee Safety within our own group first and agreed to two Safety agreements (if possible, no mention of professions & use "I" statements), plus there's a tool to ask for silence to check in with self & HP for 30 sec if needed at any time. We want to keep our interactions within the 12 Traditions.

We read part of the Virtual Office committee motion on Meeting Safety that inspired this ad hoc to exist and an excerpt from the Fellowship Service Manual under "What is a CoDA Meeting?". We want to keep whatever we end up creating simple for newcomers, maybe have it lead to more info & support. May end up sharing our own experiences of when we felt unsafe and what resources were available/ how accessible/ then create what was missing.
