Intro to Photoshop

To save from Photoshop when done:

Go to File menu -> Save As... Set the format to JPEG.

Upload each to Flickr when done!

1. Texture overlay

- 1. To open to photos together, select both (hold down **Command** while clicking on 2nd photo), right click, and select **Edit In > Open As Layers In Photoshop**
- 2. Rearrange layer order as needed, make sure texture is the "top" layer
- 3. Resize texture as needed by dragging the corner to resize it.
- 4. Hit enter when it is resized how you like.
- 5. Make sure the 2nd photo's layer is selected in the layers window and change the blending mode from Normal to Overlay (or Soft Light, Hard Light, etc.. try different blend modes)

2. HDR Toning

- 1. Open image in Photoshop (your choice)
- 2. Choose Image -> Adjustments -> HDR Toning...
- 3. Try a couple different "Preset" options (it's the top drop-down menu)
- 4. Find an effect you like. Adjust the sliders to see what they do.
- 5. If you need to start over, hit cancel and try again
- 6. Adjust to taste. When done, "Save As..."

3. Canvas texture

- 1. Open image in Photoshop (your choice)
- 2. Select Filter -> Texture -> Texturizer
- 3. For Texture: choose canvas
- 4. Scaling at 100%, Relief at 4, and Light at Top (or adjust as needed)
- 5. Click OK

4. Iris Blur

- 1. Open image in Photoshop
- 2. Filter menu -> Blur -> Iris

The center pin represents the area that will be in focus. You can drag the dots around to change the location. The inner large dots control where the focus gradually change from in-focus to out of focus.
