What's a cozy? For our purposes we're going to use this definition:

"A cozy is anything that encloses an inanimate object" You can knit, crochet or tunesian crochet your project. Use a pattern, perhaps one by Natalie to get an extra entry, or get creative and make one up. Use any weight of yarn... the sky's the limit!

Cozy ideas:

- Teapot cozy, mug cozy, jar cozy, headphone cozy, tape measure cozy. So many options!

To be eligible to win

- Start your cozy on/after 12/1/21.
- Complete that project by 12/31/21.
- Post your FO in this Ravelry thread with a description and/or photo that shows how you're meeting the challenge- what is your cozy covering?
- Players not on Ravelry can post on Instagram with #DCSCozyUp
- You may only enter in one place- Ravelry (this thread) OR Instagram.

Entries:

- 1 entry for your FO . Post your FO in this Ravelry thread. No chatter please. You can chat about your FOs in the End Zone Dance Thread.
- 1 additional entry if you use yarn from Knitty Natty Designs (post a second time in the thread to note that you're eligible for a second entry because of the yarn)
- Limit 1 FO per person.

Prize:

- one 1-hour Virtual Private knit or crochet lesson with Natalie
- three Love in Stitches patterns of the winner's choice
