These courses will take an integrated approach to the humanities, weaving the subject matter together rather than studying one distinct subject at a time; students must take history and English simultaneously. The classical courses will span the full school year, Sprints 1-6; a commitment to in-person attendance two full days per week is required for the full school year. Upon successful completion of the course, students will earn 10 units for US History and 10 units for English. These rigorous courses will require an extensive amount of reading and writing outside of class time. Additionally, a high degree of parental involvement is required. This is the first year of the program, and it is open to Journey students in 9th and 10th grade.
