A parent personal email must be the email used to create an application. From the admissions staff, "We can not communicate with students or use any middle school emails at login as it causes firewall issues."
Students must choose one preferred BMS staff member, ask for
their email address, and submit the email address in the application. The staff person will automatically receive a link to the recommendation form via email.
No recommendation letters are accepted.
There is no essay.
No transcript/record request needs to come from you. Mrs. Lilley will automatically upload all BMS applicants' records by January 31st. The parent release is embedded in the Essex Tech application.
Students ideally take time to learn about the programs offered at ET in order to identify the student's FIVE preferred programs of study . Their choices reflect that the student understands the purpose of an Essex Tech education: training and certification in a specific profession. (These program choices are not used after admission. Freshman make new selections.)

 □ What do I need to know about the interview? □ The interviews take place at BMS during the school day in several TBD office spaces anywhere in the building. □ Interviews last 15 minutes or less, depending on the student's answers. □ Essex Tech counselors and staff conduct interviews over the course of three days. □ Interview times and dates are scheduled after January 10th. □ Essex Tech schedules the interview date/time & lets Mrs. Lilley know. You will hear ASAP when those details are given. The interviews will be posted outside Mrs. Lilley's office, emailed, & you
will receive a pass.
☐ What if I'm on a 504/IEP?
Do you think your accommodations are relevant to an interview setting?
☐ If a student needs accommodations to successfully
complete their interview, please let Mrs. Lilley know at
mlilley@beverlyschools.org. We can ensure that the interview is scheduled in an appropriate space and at a

preferred time of day based on their needs, among other accommodations.
☐ If you are accepted, Essex Tech special education coordinators and a counselor will meet remotely with the student, their family, and counselor before the start of the fall semester to ensure the student's special education needs are met.
☐ What if I don't want to take Spanish?
☐ It's a requirement to take 2 years of Spanish at Essex Tech.
☐ What if I want to do art/band/chorus/strings/drama?
☐ Option 1: After school clubs including music or drama club
☐ Option 2: Beverly High School may be a better fit for a student
who would like to continue participating in art & music
programming. Attending Essex Tech is essentially school
choice, so BHS offerings are no longer available once you
become a student at Essex Tech.

The Application Decision & Notification Process

□ What	goes into the application decision?
	Grades: from 7th grade and 1st trimester of 8th grade
	Attendance: unexcused absences from 7th grade through 8th grade
	Conduct: suspensions or lack thereof
	Recommendation: your chosen BMS adult fills out an online form
	Interview: This is 40% of the application score.
	Luck: Out of approximately 150 BMS applicants (2022-2023) 55 students received letters of acceptance during April vacation, 9 students were accepted off the waitlist, and 54 students decided to attend Essex Tech. Many qualified students were not offered admission.
□ Wha	t happens after the admissions decision is made?
	Letters are mailed home during April vacation.
	By Wednesday of April vacation, applicants' families can view their
	status on the <u>Essex North Shore Go2CTE portal</u> .
	Accepted students' families must confirm their intention to enroll
	their child by the following week. <mark>If you received a conditional letter</mark>
	of acceptance: You must actively ACCEPT or DECLINE the offer of
	admission by replying to the admissions office.
	As families accept or decline the offer of admission, their status
	changes from "Conditional Accept Letter Sent" to "Incoming" or
	"Declined after Accepted" or "Waitlist."
	If you are accepted off the waitlist over the summer, please let the
	BHS registrar know by emailing lquill@beverlyschools.org.
	If you received a waitlist letter, you have the option to appeal. See the relevant section from their school policy copied below.

☐ You may write a letter to the superintendent at this email

☐ You must explain the reasons why your child should be
admitted to Essex Tech.
\Box The letter must be written by a parent or guardian.
☐ The letter may include <u>optional</u> supporting documents (report
cards, attendance, staff recommendation).
☐ "If ENSATS places an applicant on a waitlist, the applicant or
the parent/guardian may request a review of that decision by
sending a letter to the Superintendent-Director within
fourteen days of notification of placement. Appellants are
encouraged to provide written documentation or verification
to support their request for reconsideration of an application
(e.g. grade reports, attendance documentation, etc.) in their
appeal. All appeal requests must be made in writing to the
Superintendent-Director and be forwarded to:
appeals@essextech.net or Admissions-Appeals, Essex
North Shore Agricultural & Technical School District, 565
Maple Street, Hathorne, MA 01937. The District will respond
to these requests for review in writing and indicate whether
the decision to waitlist the student will stand or be overturned
