




Running a Hangout:

Step 1: Click on your Hangout Link


If you are on time or just a bit late for the hangout, the link will look like this:




If you are early and want to get the hangout set up for your participants, the link will look like this:




Step 2: Invite any last minute participants




Step 4: Set up any Hangout Apps you need.




Adding a Lower Third to your Video

Step 1: Add the hangout toolbox app to your hangout




Step 2: Input your title and upload logo (optional)




Step 3: Turn your Lower Third On

Don't worry, it is supposed to look backwards to you. It will look correct to everyone else.
















