Chairs—Complete Your District Dates Form

It's time to fill out the District Dates Form in Tabroom.com! This form tells us information about your district tournament series. **If your district intends to hold any portion of your district tournament series in 2024 (before the new year), your District Dates Form is due October 31.** If you are waiting until 2025 to start your tournament series, then you have until November 30 to submit the form. Make a Plan to Determine Your Student Leadership Council Nominee

Nominations opened this week for the 2025-2026 NSDA [Student Leadership Council](#) (SLC). This group is composed of students from various NSDA districts and works to ensure the NSDA is meeting students' needs. High school member students who will graduate in 2026, 2027, or 2028 are eligible for nomination for next year's Council. Coaches may submit nominations by February 15 through a [standard online form](#), which sends a copy to both the national office and the district chair with the subject line *Student Leadership Council Nomination Form [Student Name]*. Each district has the opportunity to nominate one member student for consideration. District winners must be [reported](#) by the district chair by March 1. The final SLC will be selected in April. This is a unique way to influence the organization's future and an excellent addition to any student's resume. We encourage all districts to offer this opportunity to students by helping to promote the program to coaches and reviewing all nominations you receive.
