Squamous cell carcinoma (left eye)

Suresh Kumar a 62-year-old man from Chitrakoot, Uttar Pradesh. His problem started in February 2026 with redness in his left eye. At first, he used over-the-counter eye drops, but there was no improvement. He then visited **Janaki Kund Eye Hospital**. After some time, a small cyst appeared on his left upper eyelid. Doctors performed a CT scan and a biopsy to examine the swelling. The swelling gradually became larger and doctors suspected as squamous cell carcinoma (cancer) involving his left eye. His left eye was bulging forward (proptosis). He also had a history of inverted papilloma in the nasal cavity, for which he had surgeries in 2011 and again in 2021.

Later, he applied a traditional neem paste (Neem Lepam). After using it, the swelling became smaller to some extent. However, the wound above the left upper eyelid continued to discharge pus and sometimes bled slightly. He also had mild pain in that area.

He later underwent another biopsy at **Madan Mohan Malaviya Hospital, Varanasi**. The biopsy confirmed that the lesion was cancerous. After the diagnosis, the doctors advised chemotherapy, and the first chemotherapy session was planned for 27 April 2026.

Before starting chemotherapy, the patient visited Dr. BRC office for a second opinion and enrolled in the VOPD service on 9 April 2026.

According to the patient, he started feeling better within about 15 days of beginning treatment at our centre. The tumour gradually became smaller, and the pus discharge reduced a lot. Over the next few weeks, his condition continued to improve.

At present, the patient reports that he has no pain and no pus discharge from the wound. The tumour has reduced greatly in size, making him much more comfortable and improving his quality of life.

These improvements were seen after the patient started our virtual OPD treatment. He will continue to be monitored with regular clinical check-ups to assess his long-term progress and disease status.
