Core Contribution Guidelines

- No Fan-Fiction: Fan-fiction, myths, and unconfirmed lore are not permitted in articles. They belong in the User Sandbox.
- Write Neutral Descriptions: Avoid using definitive or opinionated language (such as "is based on"). Instead, use objective phrasing like "is primarily inspired by".
- Avoid "Trivia" Sections: If possible, integrate real-world influences, vehicle details, and pop-culture references into the main body of the article.
- Use Inline Citations: Reference your claims if you are detailing glitches, beta content, or data mined directly from game files. [\[1, 2, 3, 5\]](#)

Image Uploads

- File Naming: Name your files logically using hyphens to separate the subject, the game, and a description (e.g., `SubjectName-GTAgame-Description.png`). Avoid using generic names like `screenshot1.jpg`.

- Aspect Ratio: Gameplay screenshots and visual depictions should ideally use a 16:9 aspect ratio. Tall buildings and character headshots utilize 1:1, while full-body character variations use 9:16. [1](#), [2](#)

Talk Pages

- Be Civil: Always remain courteous when discussing changes with other editors.
- Sign Your Comments: Never sign the articles you edit or create, as the edit history tracks your contributions. However, when posting on Talk Pages, use four tildes (`\(\sim\sim\sim\sim\)`) to automatically sign your posts. [1](#), [2](#), [3](#)
