### Verse Drawing Sheet (Younger and Older)

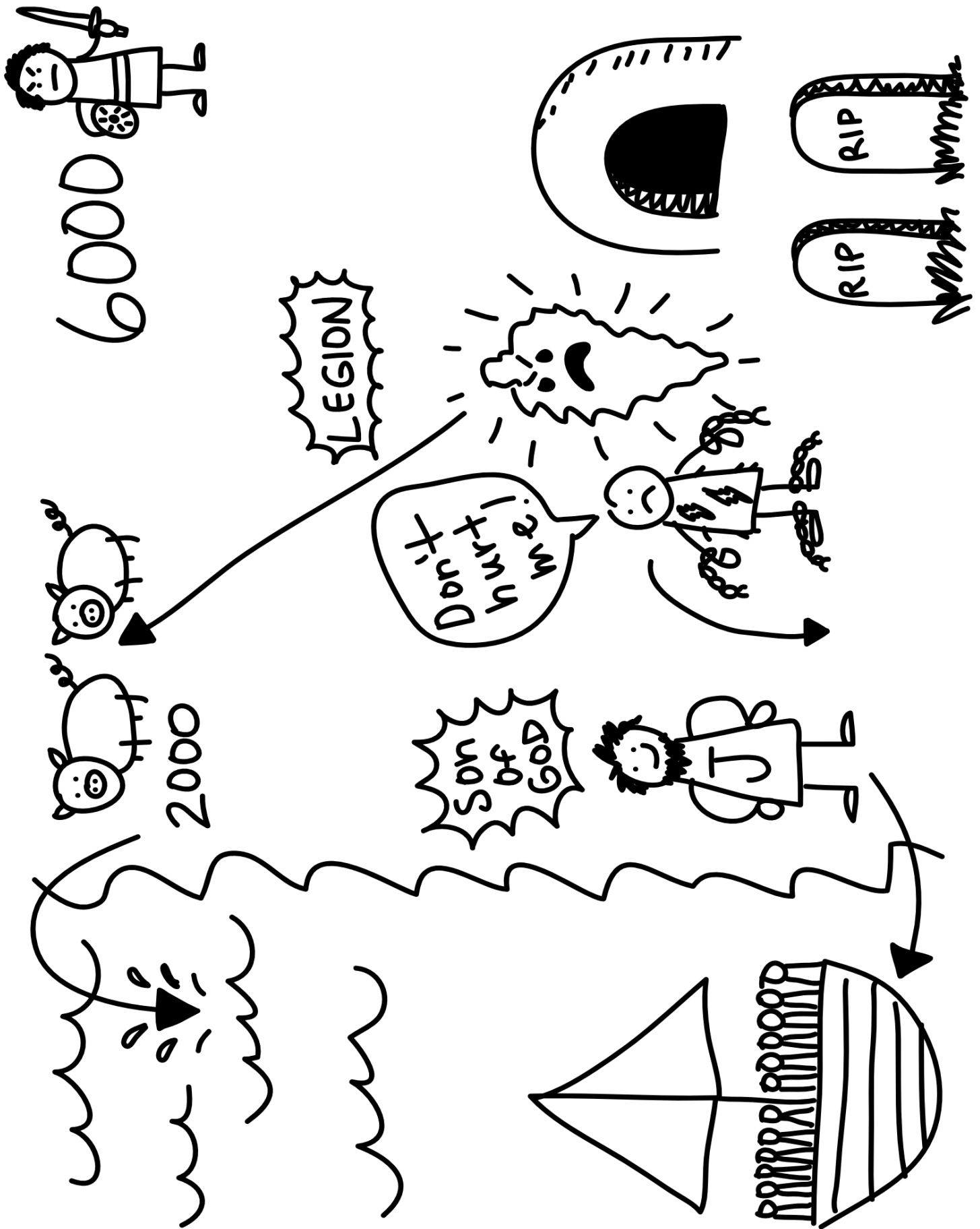
- Print one copy on white paper for each child. There are two versions, for older and younger children.

## Review Activity Script

### Instructions:

- Tell the kids to do whatever you describe as you read the story below. Encourage them to use big hand gestures and over-dramatic acting. The more you read the dialogue with energy and inflection, the more they will use after they repeat after you.
- - - - indicates a time to pause and allow the children to act out what you just read.
- \*\*\* indicates dialogue for you to read and the children to repeat.
- ► indicates actions for the children to perform.

### Script:

- A man had an evil spirit. - - - He screamed day and night. - - - He was so strong that he could break chains. - - - The man with an evil spirit came running to Jesus. - - -
- \*\*\* Jesus said...
  - *Come out of him!*
- \*\*\* The man said to Jesus...
  - *What do you want with me...*
  - *...Son of the Most High God?*
  - *Promise you won't hurt me!*
- \*\*\* Jesus said...
  - *What is your name?*
- \*\*\* The man with the evil spirit said...
  - *Legion...*
  - *...because we are many.*
  - *Please! Let us go into the pigs!*
- \*\*\* Jesus said...
  - *You may go into the pigs.*
- The evil spirit left the man and went into the pigs.
- ► Have the “man” walk over and tap the Pig on the head.
- ► Have the Pig let out a loud squeal.
- The pigs ran right down a steep bank --- fell into the water --- and drowned.
- ► Have the Pig dive into the Pile of Pillows/Old Mattress.
- The man who had the evil spirit was now acting normally.
- ► Tell him to give Jesus a high-five.
