Membership

Individual Memberships

Individual Annual

\$100.00 USD every 12 months

Individual membership is billed annually and includes one access key to the club. This Membership is not available through PayPal.

Individual Monthly

\$10.00 USD every month

Individual membership is billed monthly and includes one access key to the club. This membership is available through PayPal.

Household Memberships

Household Annual

\$175.00 USD every 12 months

Household membership is billed annually and includes two access keys to the club. This Membership is not available through PayPal.

Household Add-on

\$50.00 USD every 12 months

This subscription is billed annually in addition to the Household Annual Membership and includes one access key to the club. This Membership is not available through PayPal.

Associate & Junior Memberships

Associate Membership

\$10.00 USD every month

An Associate membership is awarded to guests with 3 to 6 months of sobriety, billed monthly. *No Key Card. This membership is available through PayPal.

Junior Membership

\$5.00 USD every month

A Junior membership is available to guests 18 to 21 years of age, billed monthly. *No Key Card. This membership is available through PayPal.
