- Meeting Called to Order at 8:09 a.m. started with round table introduction
- <u>Sellwood Data Deck OSAS Spring 2024-25 and MAP Fall 2025</u> Principal Carbone presented the OSAS Spring 2024-2025.
 - Note Science Data only tests 8th Graders, tends to see larger swings because of the smaller sample size.
 - Class size as down slightly last year, there was an extra teacher funded by foundation dollars.
 - Scores Trend for Math and Language
 - Large Dip after the pandemic, Math has recovered to pre-pandemic levels, English/Language arts is lagging behind but improving.
 - Student score distributions More than half of students are at the high proficiency level
 - Disaggregated by Race: Black students need more attention, small group of students a significant portion of which are dealing with personal hardships.
 - Small portion of students in this group make it hard to get resources targeted for their needs
 - Martha suggests mentorship programs. Jeandre is open to suggestion for ways of getting mentorship, tutoring programs.
 - Trying to build in flex Fridays with the Advisory Program
 - Design in a "What I need" block on early Wednesdays
 - Cleveland high school student mentor Program

- Mission Statement Discussion

 - Student says their teacher uses it to guide his lessons plans
