Greek Philosophy Seminar Guidelines

The class will be run as a seminar. Most classes will be devoted to a round-table discussion of the assigned readings. The ideal to be aimed at is something like a civilized conversation around a dinner table between friends who are united by a common interest in the subject and respect for one another's ideas. To help us achieve this goal certain expectations should be met and guidelines followed:

- · You should have studied the text beforehand.
- · You should bring the text to class.
- · You should be fully engaged for the entire period.
- · Non-alcoholic drinks are permitted.
- · No food of any kind is permitted.
- · All cell phones must be turned off and put away.
- · Any internet connections must be closed.
- · Multitasking (e.g. knitting, drawing) is not permitted.
- · Only the text, writing materials, and drinks should be on the table.
- · Don't interrupt the person who is speaking.
- · Differences of opinion should be expressed in a civil manner.
