### ❖ 1. HB 293: Public Education Student Athlete Protections

#### Summary

This bill prohibits a public school from participating in an association that governs athletic interscholastic activities if the association does not: include certain policies in the association's policies; or sufficiently enforce the association's rules and policies

## Talking Points

1) Creates practice limits. 2) Creates longer moratoriums for sports. Moratoriums for ALL sports during Independence Day, Thanksgiving, and Winter Break. A concern with this moratorium is that many tournaments occur during these periods, allowing student-athletes to participate without missing school. 3) Sport-specific moratoriums in the off-season of at least 8 weeks; 4) Practice limit of 15 hours per week (3 hours per day)-- this would include team meetings, film study, etc. 5) Weight training or conditioning classes would be excluded as long as they are not dedicated to a specific team or sport.

## **2. HB 360: School Athlete Amendments - (AD's need to be proactive, call your representative)**

### Summary

This bill prohibits a public school from participating in an activities association that imposes periods of ineligibility on students who transfer due to open enrollment, school choice, or bullying

### Talking Points

1) It basically states that if a student transfers during the open enrollment period, even if they played at another school and established eligibility the year prior, they would be fully eligible at the varsity level to participate. 2) Based on conversations in our community with parents, this becomes a major issue and point of contention between our high schools as well as our relationships with other high schools. We could see an increased number of athletes who move in to compete at the varsity level for just one year and then transfer the next year to a more prestigious program. It eliminates high school sports as a neighborhood sport. 3) However, with NIL money now influencing high school athletes, this will be a tricky situation to monitor. We already know that athletes transfer and with NIL money, they are often able to establish residency through full family moves.

## **2. SB 271: High School Activities Governance**

A new bill that just hit the floor on Friday, February 6, 2026. Looks to dissolve the UHSAA.
