#### Introduction

Manuscript length 10 to 20 pages, font 11pt, Times New Roman, single space. In Tech can overwhelmingly accept shorter or longer manuscripts, provided the scientific content is of high value. Additional page fees may be charged if the manuscript is substantially longer than 20 pages.

Sub-heading writing is not necessary with numbering. Simply

written With Thickening (Bold) Only. While to write citations in using the Harvard system, such as: (Miller and Smith 1994) or Miller and Smith (1994). Try to use management references. The use of management references such as zotero, mendeley will make it easier for the author.

#### Discussion

In the discussion section there is no need to write a discussion subtitle. As in this template, simply written sub-headings of the discussion are written boldly. [for font 11pt Times New Roman].

Articles can contain tables and/or images. Tables or pictures should not be too long, too big and too much. Authors should use variations in table and drawing presentations. The tables and images presented should be referenced in the text. The size of the table fill letter can be reduced




Figure 1. Data xxxxxx
