Remember this is your first time doing this! Be patient and have fun! Brene Brown calls them FFT (F** First Times): naming the FFT leads to three steps. One, we can normalize it, “Oh, this is exactly how new is supposed to feel. This is uncomfortable because brave is uncomfortable.” Two, we can put it in perspective, “This feeling is not permanent, and it doesn’t mean I suck at everything. It means I’m in the middle of an FFT around this one thing.” Three, I can reality check my expectations, “This is going to suck for a while. 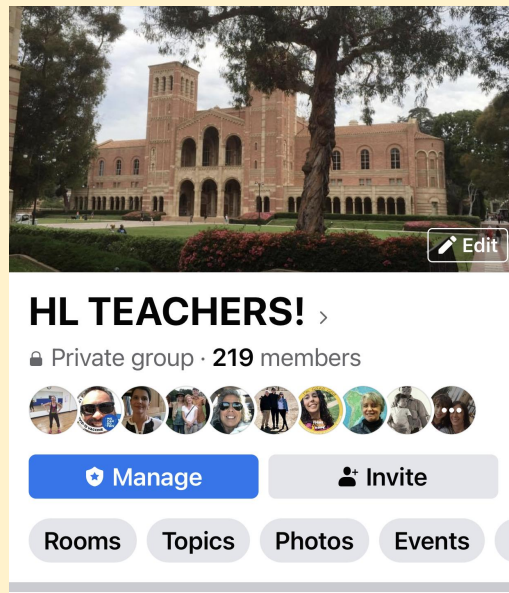
