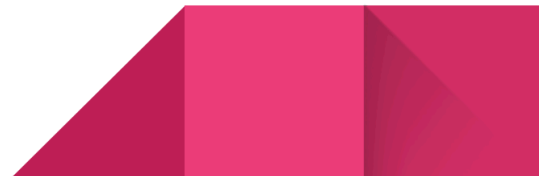

April - IAR TEST INFORMATION

The IAR is a computer-based standardized assessment for all students in Grades 3 - 8 that is designed to measure students' progress toward the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics, as well as the Standards for Mathematical Practices. District administrators and teachers will work together to examine the results. This will provide the school district with information on student learning and facilitate continuous improvement of our educational programs.
