

Guidelines for Building an Improvement Plan

- There are 7 required high school-level goals:
1)State assessment results in reading and mathematics, 2)State assessment results in science, social studies, and writing, 3)English Learner Progress, 4)Quality of School Climate and Safety, 5)Postsecondary Readiness, 6)Graduation Rate, 7)Achievement Gap

1: State Assessment Results in Reading and Mathematics Goal

Goal 1: To reduce the percentage of Novice from 24% to 19% in 10th grade Reading scores. To reduce the percentage of Novice from 22% to 17% in 10th grade Mathematics scores.

2: State Assessment Results in Science, Social Studies, and Writing Goal

Goal 2: To reduce the percentage of Novice from 37% to 30% in 11th grade Science scores. To reduce the percentage of Novice from 28% to 20% in 11th grade Social Studies scores. To improve the Combined Writing index score of all students in writing from 76.5 to 80% as defined by the On-Demand writing assessment in 2024-25.

3: English Learner Progress Goal

Goal 3: To continue to reduce the percentage of Novice in all content areas for all English Language Learners. We currently do not have the number of ELL students to meet the threshold to receive a score via the Kentucky Accountability System.

4: Quality of School Climate and Safety Goal

Goal 4: To improve the quality of school climate and safety goal from 71.6 to 75.

5: Postsecondary Readiness Goal

Goal 5: To improve the Postsecondary Readiness (academic and career) score from 104.6 to 107.0 by 2024-25.

6: Graduation Rate Goal

Goal 6: To improve the graduation rate goal from 95.7% to 99.0% by 2024-25.

7: Achievement Gap Goal

Goal 7: To reduce the percentage of Novice in the gap group of “Economically Disadvantaged” on the Kentucky Summative Assessment Reading section from 30% to 25% in 2024-25.
