- Starting in our Spring 2021 issue, there will be a regular column dedicated to chiropractic philosophy. Each quarter, Jon Eckfeld will conduct a review of a book on chiropractic philosophy.
- Current Lifelines Pay Structure:
 - Staff writers are asked to produce 2 articles per quarter and are paid \$150 per quarter. The first is editorial content (\$60) and the second is a scientific research article (\$90).
 - One-off contributors receive \$45 for editorial content and \$60 for scientific research articles.
- Proposed Pay Structure:
 - Staff writers are asked to produce 1 to 2 articles per quarter and are paid \$100 per article.
 - One-off contributors receive \$75 for either editorial content or a scientific research article.
- Rationale:
 - Current pay structure may lack sufficient incentive for a greater number of students to participate in article submissions.
 - Current requirement for staff writers to produce 2 articles per quarter is a barrier to more students participating as regular staff writers.
 - It is this editor's opinion that editorial content is as valuable as scientific research articles and should be compensated for equivalently.
 - For their commitment to regular submissions, staff writers continue to receive greater compensation per submission than one-off contributors.
- Risks:
 - All submitted content will be of editorial format.
