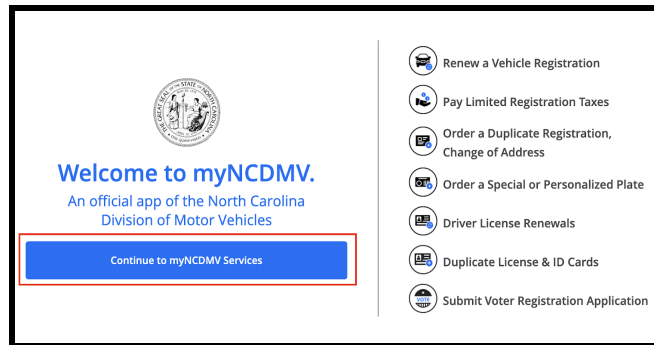

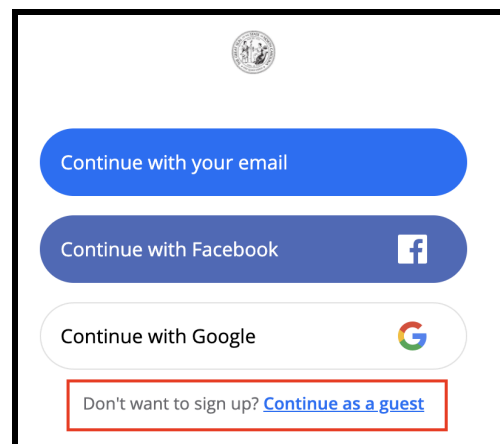

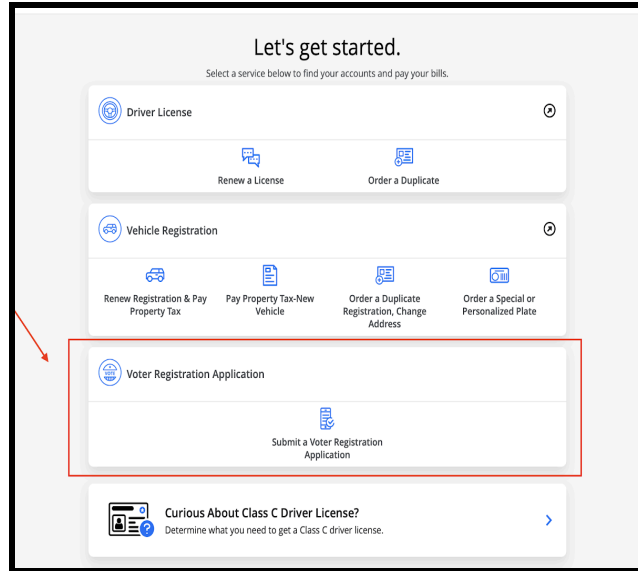

If you do not have a valid North Carolina Driver License or DMV-issued ID Card, you can download a voter registration application and submit it to the State Board of Elections.

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Next, it will ask you to review all voting requirements:

- A U.S. citizen;
- At least 18 years old by the day of the General Election;
- A resident of the county for at least 30 days before the election in which you want to vote;
- A person who is not serving a felony sentence, including probation or parole.
- A 17 year old may register and vote in a Primary if they will be 18 on the day of the General Election; in the Primary, they may only vote on contests that will appear on the General Election ballot.

If you fit the requirements, click **"Continue"**.

It will then ask you to attest under penalty of perjury, that in addition to having read and understood the contents of the online application for voter registration, that you fit the voter requirements listed on step 6.
