Course Overview:

In our Adult & Pediatric CPR class, you'll learn essential life-saving skills for both children and adults. We'll cover CPR, AED use, and how to administer Epinephrine and Naloxone in a life threatening emergency.

- Recognize the signs of cardiac arrest in adults, children, and infants.
- Practice delivering effective chest compressions and rescue breathing.
- Learn to operate an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) to restore a heartbeat.
- Develop the skills to assist in choking emergencies.
- Recognize an opioid overdose and learn how to intervene.
- Administer naloxone (Narcan) using nasal spray or injection.
- Administer epinephrine (Epi-Pen) using an autoinjector.
- Understand and practice harm reduction and community care in an overdose response.
- Learn about Good Samaritan laws that protect those who help.
- Each participant will leave with 2, 3mg or 4mg naloxone doses, and a CPR face shield.

Intended Audience:

- Neighbors, activists, and volunteers
- Parents, teachers, youth leaders, and childcare providers
- Coaches, outdoor educators, and organizers
- People working in harm reduction, mutual aid, and social service spaces

Course Format:

- **Duration:** 6 hours total - 2 hours self paced online component, and a 4 hour skills session.
- Hands-on practice with CPR mannequins, AED trainers, Epinephrine and naloxone trainers.
- Our small class size prioritizes the learning material. We want you to ask questions and feel confident and competent after the class.
- Participants will receive Red Cross certifications in Adult & Pediatric CPR/AED and Naloxone Administration. This certificate is valid for two years.
