- 2. The people there decide to sacrifice bulls to them as if they are gods, but Paul and Barnabas keep the people from doing so.
- A group of outsiders form a mob and stone Paul and drag him out of the city.
  When some disciples surround his body, Paul gets up and leaves town with Barnabas.
