**Daily Expectations:**

**Assignments:**

- Complete assignments by their due dates and in the correct format. There is NO extra credit.
- All written work completed outside of class MUST be prepared according to assignment requirements BEFORE you enter the classroom.
  - Typed assignments will be formatted according to MLA guidelines.
  - Handwritten work will frequently be required.
- Lateness
  - Any major assignments or projects (where you are given an extended period to complete them) are due on the assigned due date, whether you are present or not.
  - Major assignments will lose 10% each class meeting they are late.
  - Minor assignments that are late may not be eligible for credit at all.

**Grading:**

- The high school uses semester grading. The first semester ends in January..

- Students earning less than 50% on any major assessment (10% or more of the semester grade), may seek remediation. Remediation assessments are at the discretion of the teacher/ supervisor.
- Grades are **NOT** negotiable. (If a grading error is made, please show us and it will be corrected. Otherwise, your grade stands.) There is no further discussion necessary on this topic.
