## School Closure Due to COVID-19 For the week of March 16-20, 2020

In consultation with State directors, we will cancel school **Monday-Friday next week (March 16-20, 2020)** in an attempt to dilute the spread of COVID-19 contagion in the community. Both the city and county have or will be making their own declarations of emergency. We will host optional conferences today, and your school principals will meet with their staff to review expectations for staff during this time of school closure.

Most importantly, you are community, and today provides a bit of time for the ASD community to reassure each other that we are safe - there is much fear tied to this viral event - and to have time together prior to a two week separation will give each and every one of our staff time to share stories, have closure, and construct meaning for how to navigate this new normal of social isolation.

## There are effective ways to reduce the risk to yourself and the people you care about.

- Frequently and thoroughly wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
  - If soap and water are not available, use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash or use your inner elbow or sleeve.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- Stay home if you're sick, and keep your children home if they are sick.
- Clean surfaces in your home, and personal items such as cell phones, using regular household products.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Clean frequently touched surfaces and objects daily using regular household detergent and water
- It is not necessary to wear a facemask to protect yourself if you are not sick. Face masks should be used by people who show symptoms of COVID-19 to help prevent the spread of the disease to others.
