4-H High School grads are welcome to apply for scholarship money that is budgeted each year from the Federation Funds. To apply, 4-H'ers must meet the qualifications provided below.

Requirements and Information:

1. Applicants must be a high school senior graduating in 2025/or college freshman who has not previously received the scholarship.
2. Applicant must have completed 5 years of active membership in Washington County 4-H.
3. Applicant must be a current Washington County 4-H member that will be attending an accredited college, university, community college or technical college as of fall quarter/semester 2025.
4. The Washington County Federation scholarship is not limited to specific majors or universities.
5. Scholarships are awarded based on the content written in the application. All names are removed from the application so applications are anonymous when reviewed by the selection committee.
6. Scholarships are awarded based on scholarship selection committee review.
7. Scholarship winners will be announced at the County Fair Recognition Program Sunday evening at the county fair.
