The quality of health services in Tanzania has currently been improved by the government. Better curative and preventive health services are offered to the community. There are currently better and advanced medical equipments in the regional and referral hospitals than it was in the previous days. The medical personnel's are more equipped with protective tools. At the preventive level the government has improved nutrition, environmental health, reproductive health and control of infectious diseases like HIV/AIDS, cholera, leprosy and diarrhea. The accessibility of Tanzanians to

medical centre services is better than the previous days. This is due to the improvement and expansion of transport system in different parts of the country. In addition, more government and private's health facilities have been built in different areas all over the country.

Despite of various measures taken by the government on improving health services, the distribution of quality health services in Tanzania are very poor and those better services are still concentrated in towns and cities like Dar es salaam, Mbeya city, etc. the problems of inadequate personnel's and medical equipments are still debatable in the rural areas. The government should increase the recruitment of personnel of the health experts and medical equipments in both urban and rural areas for the public to enjoy the health services in their geographical location in the country. But also improvement of transport means is the hub to cure the situation in the country.
