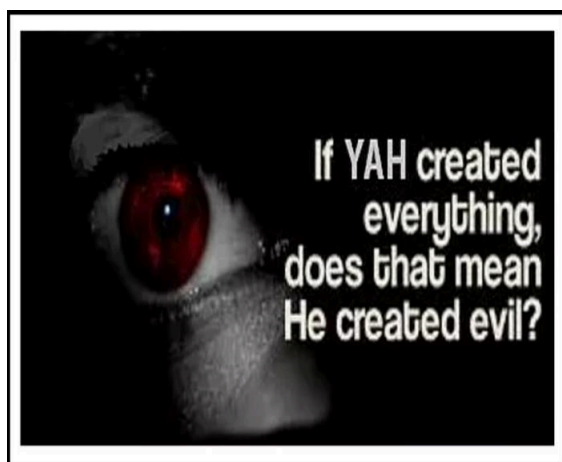


Did 𐤏𐤃 Created the Sin of Evil?
