Assignment: The students will use Digital Images that they have scanned, or have shot and make either Brown Tone (Sepia) or Black and White Colored digital print. The Rules of Composition are demonstrated in the pictures they take and/or select. The Brown Tone (Sepia)/ Black and White Colored digital print processes will be learned using Photoshop. The students will each turn in 5 digital prints [6" x 4" 300 resolution], either Brown Tone or Black and White Selected Colored process will be used.
