Matthew: So which of these little nuggets stuck out as the biggest upsets?

Snoop: It all starts with the title holders. 4 out of 5 lost their belts and only my fair Kiwi Ella defended hers. *Vita Sidorkina, aka The Lioness*, was the biggest surprise. Vita has been keepin' that belt since 2022 my man and this was her first title loss ever.

LOOKING BACK ON LOSING STREAKS

Snoop: And there's more. 19 lovely ladies put their 3 fight losing streaks to an end fo sho.

Snoop: Check this out, my friends. Bella Heathcote's big win streak got cut short by Azealia Banks, who finally snagged a win after seven straight L's. And it keeps rollin'. Sierra Skye Egan's win streak was ended by **Yelena Isinbayeva**, who was on a seven-fight losing streak.
