 - Jason showed RID board, specifically the inventory portion
 - > We had account requests from 3 counties that had not been involved previously
- 10 min: Unfinished business Steering Committee Members
 - > Standardized Incident Naming Conventions Voting Results
 - The form to vote is still open so that we can get input from enough steering committee members
 - Further discussion (Skyler)
 - Current process at DEM is to add FEMA declaration number to existing incident
 - For example, --- DR-4548 5.7 Earthquake UT20 0 222
 - In the naming convention open for the steering committee to vote on, the above incident could be named like this: DEM DR-4548 Earthquake 2022-10
 - Can an existing incident be renamed?
 - ♦ Yes
 - Can incident ownership be transferred?
 - ◆ Incident is global for the most part, but incident gets assigned to groups
 - ◆ Adding an existing incident to additional groups is definitely possible
 - Need to have a written procedure for "promoting" a local incident to a statewide incident
 - Written process for doing the back end admin to ensure correct group permissions
 - > Process for notifying users of incident escalation(?)
 - Recommend a separate prefix to denote incidents that are statewide vs "just" a DEM incident
 - ◆ Josh will add this to the next form for steering committee to vote on → process to promote local incidents to statewide
 - Resource Request Process Workflow Skyler and Tara
 - No updates on this process this week

- We have heard requests for this from several stakeholders
- Once a county goes outside of their region, then it would go up to the state
- We don't really have a jurisdiction that serves as a "regional administrator"
- It functions as more of a cooperative agreement
- One recommendation is that a county could request resources from another county, but if the request was outside of their region the state would be notified
- Counties could also push a request to the state and ask the state to look for resources in other regions
- Recommend further discussion before tweaking current escalation process
