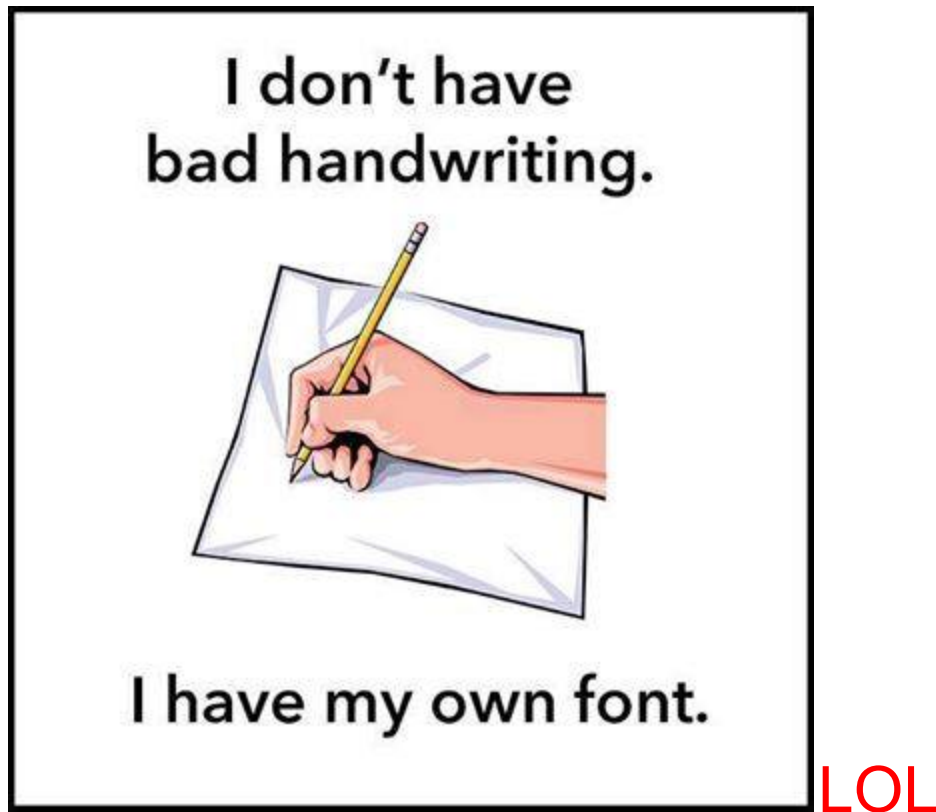


Writing Practice for Basic 2

Most of the time, I don't talk about it much because people just don't understand.

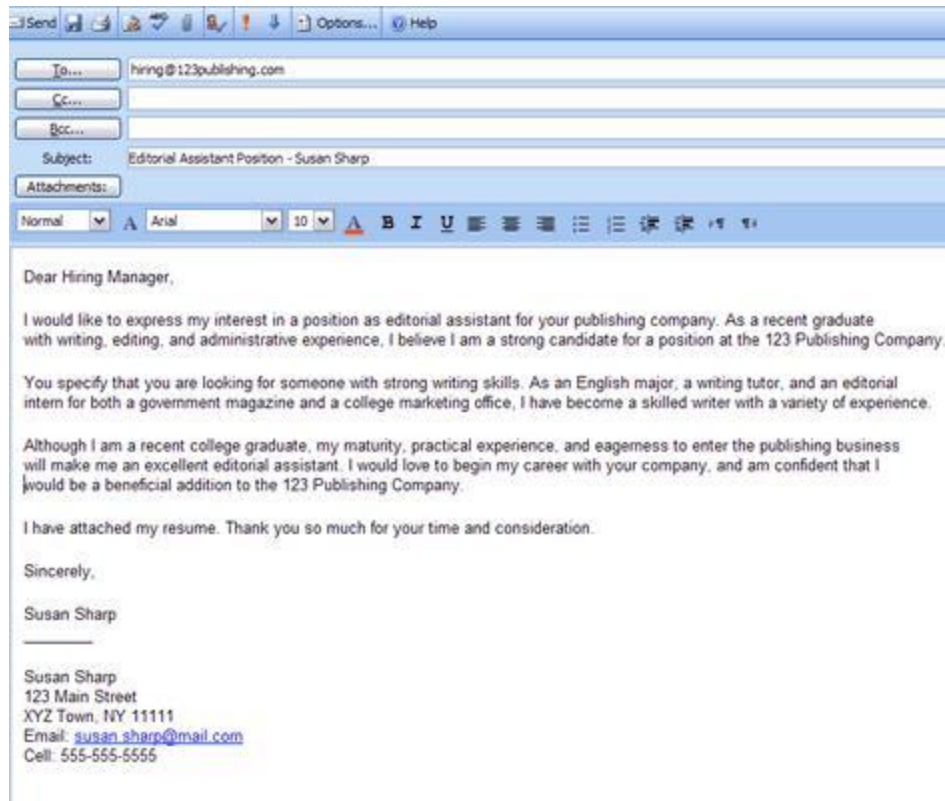

How are you?

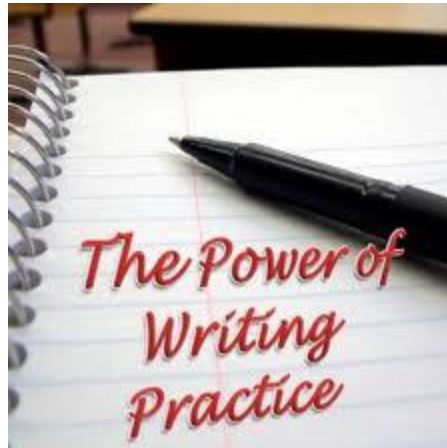
We missed you at my birthday party last week. I imagine you were very busy all week. What did you do? Waiting for your answer.
