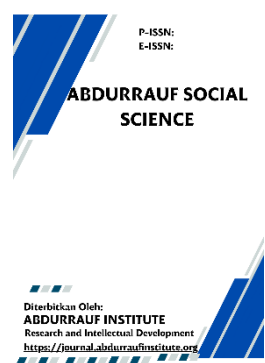


Figure 1. Cover of the Journal
