The Betting Pool is a level 100 trial introduced in patch 7.6. It is part of the <<TMTO>> questline.


### Conman Extraordinaire: Gale L'Ocean

This is a non-combat boss fight. Phases are composed of various mechanics players will have to successfully complete or dodge. Players who fail twice during any phase will receive a Bad Debt debuff until the end of the phase. Debuffs will stack at the end of each phase. At least four players must survive the mechanics to proceed to the next phase. If five or more players fail the mechanics, you'll be drained of your funds and forced to re-enter the fight with a minimum of 100 000 gil in your coin purse.

Upon entering the battle, all players will be given a **Debt Meter**. This meter directly correlates with the amount of Gil you currently have on hand. It is recommended that you enter the trial with the minimum requirement of 100 000 gil, as failing any mechanic will cause you to lose 25%-100% of your total sum.

#### Phase 1

- Testing the Waters: Players will be pulled into two parties of four on each side of the arena, sectioned off by a clear barrier. Actions and Skills will be unavailable.
- Full Deck: Occurs immediately after Testing the Waters. A series of six cards, numbered one to six, will appear in a random order on each side of the arena. After ten seconds, they will transform into a transparent deck void of any numbers.
- Pair: Party members on each side will have eight seconds each to run under a card of the same number, creating a match. A card will only reveal itself if four players are standing underneath. Creating a false match twice will result in failure.
- Debt Collection: Players afflicted with the Rad Debt debuff will have 25% of their total gil collected.



#### Phase 2

- Loan: Each player's health will lower to a random amount ranging between 1000 to 10 000 hp. This will serve as the player's "Loan". Actions and Skills will be unavailable.
- Interest: Four gil piles will spawn on the arena in varying amounts. Each player will have an individual owing interest displayed on their screen in relation to their HP and will have sixty seconds to collect the exact amount of gil needed to pay off their loan all while dodging anvils falling from the sky. Getting hit by an anvil results in dropping your gil and you will need to re-collect it. Carry it into the AoE of Gale's henchman, Isarmoix (Located north of the arena) to complete the mechanic.

  Note that he will only accept the exact amount needed. Anything under or over will result in failure.
- **Down On Their Luck**: The same mechanic as **Interest**, but you are instead collecting the debt for the player you are tethered to. Tethers during this phase are **One-sided** and **will only be displayed on your screen**. Failing to properly collect the player's loan will result in their failure.
- Pay Day: The resolution of Down On Their Luck. Gale will count his earnings and reveal who succeeded and who failed the mechanic. If the player's health reaches one, they have succeeded. Anything over one results in a debt debuff.
- Debt Collection: Players afflicted with the Bad Debt debuff will have 50% of their total gil collected.

#### Phase 3

- **Hired Help**: Spawns a possible four of twelve Debtors. Each Debtor has unique traits and circumstances related to the fight and are randomized. Actions and Skills are now available to use in battle.
- One Eye Open: Debtors will auto-attack whoever has aggro before executing their individual special skills. A list of skills and how to resolve them can be found under Debtors. There are many combinations, so it's recommended that parties proceed with caution and assign two members to each Debtor for observation. Getting hit by the Debtor's special skill twice results in debt debuffs.
- Last Stand: After the Debtor's HP hits one, they will spread to all four corners of the arena. They will start casting their special skill, but will switch places with another Debtor just before the cast resolves. You can tell where the Debtor will switch by selecting them and observing which Debtor they are selected on. Place yourself in accordance.
- Debt Collection: Players afflicted with the Bad Debt debuff will have 75% of their total gil collected.

#### Phase 4

- Eye for an Eye: After his transformation into a Lalafell, Gale will throw a Phial of Fantasia at each player, inflicting them with the Lalafell transformation status. This status effectively lowers your defense against larger creatures and gives a Heavy and Hysteria debuff. Lalafell players are immune to this status.
- Dinner Bell (Summon): Four Goobbue and Four Morbols adds are called to the field, each tethered to a player.
- Take-out: Goobbue adds will Inhale in the direction of their tethers, while Morbols will inflict cone AoEs of Bad Breath. Players must place themselves at an appropriate distance and direction before the cast bars resolve so as to not hit other players. Getting hit by any of these mechanics twice results in immediate failure. If you are afflicted with Hysteria, it is recommended to have a healer rescue you to a safe position. These adds will repeat the mechanic until defeated.
- Permanent Debt: Players afflicted with the Bad Debt debuff will have 100% of their total gil collected. At least 4 players must not have this debuff by the end of the cast timer in order to successfully clear the trial.


