## **Course Description and Learning Outcomes:**

These are advanced classes in technical theatre. Students should already have a working knowledge of the stage facilities including public address systems, lights, sound and miscellaneous operations. In Advanced Tech, students are responsible for design and production of technical elements for Theatre productions. This course requires out-of-school-time participation. Students must be able to self-motivate and make strong use of the available work time given to them. In Tech Lab, students will dive deeper into the practical aspects and skills required in technical theatre.

#### **Student Crews:**

Throughout the course of the year, students will be placed on various crews in Advanced tech (lighting crew, costume crew, etc.) for the fall musical and spring play. As a crew, students will see through the production of their area from design to creation to implementation during the shows.

#### **After School Commitment:**

As part of the stage crew, students will help to create and run the technical elements for each show. There will be after-school work times, typically on Tuesday and Thursday from 4:30-6:30 pm and some Saturdays from 10-2. (Times may vary depending on rehearsal schedule.) Students are required to complete at least 7 tech hours per term for advanced tech and 5 tech hours per term for tech lab. Students may be required to attend some after-school rehearsals and must attend all mandatory tech/dress rehearsals and performances. There is no makeup available for missed mandatory dates. Students will also be required to attend one full run-through of the show prior to technical rehearsals.

## **Mandatory Dates:**

There is NO makeup for missed mandatory dates. Students who cannot attend all mandatory dates will not be selected for Advanced Tech

### Rehearsal and class expectations:

all mandatory dates.

- Attend each rehearsal for which a technician is called, on time
- Fully engage in and participate on designated crew
- Listen to and follow instructions
- Do not leave rehearsals or tech days without permission
- Treat all materials and facilities with respect
- Follow all safety rules and protocols
- Technicians should not bring any outside guests to rehearsals or work days without permission
- Technicians should not bring any food into the auditorium
- Students will be expected to PLAN AHEAD. Be smart. Your life is not owned by the theatre department. Make sure that you are organized and that you get work done for your other classes, and that you get enough sleep. Communication is key! If problems arise, talk to Miss Detweiler, she will work with you.
- You cannot tech a show if you are failing any of your classes, or have any U's. Plan ahead!
- Have a positive attitude on stage and off. Students should not talk negatively about the production staff or cast and crew members. Respect the director, music director, and choreographer by listening and paying attention during rehearsals. If a problem arises, speak with the director privately.
- **Support Others-** Venting to other cast members or crew about concerns is not acceptable. Please come to Miss Detweiler with any concerns.
- Contribute to an overall positive class atmosphere-There should be no bullying, hazing or harassment of any kind. This includes during, after school and online, over text etc.

If a technician consistently fails to demonstrate expected rehearsal behavior, they will be asked to leave the class.
