

Public Engagement Seal Course Options

Students working to earn the public engagement seal must complete a minimum of two courses that help them to build knowledge and skills related to understanding inequity and social and political issues, communicating about these inequities and issues, and engaging in advocacy and activism to address them. We encourage students to take courses from multiple disciplines. These courses have been pre-approved by the Center for Civic Engagement. Students may Salem State University Courses not listed or those taken at other institutions for consideration to the Faculty Fellow For Civic Engagement or the Assistant Director for the Center for Civic Engagement for approval.
