Noticing	Leanne spoke about the depth of collaborative planning on staff. Teachers are owning what we are assessing what we are focusing on. Staff are a strength. REally great authentic progression and authentic integration into the classroom. Good use of new curriculum framework.	
Investigating	Why is year 4 always high? Do any children challenge it? - ie do they question it e.g. how do we know God exists? Rubric: 1,2 and 3 - 3 = top end of school.	
Collaborative Sense-making	Older children are encouraged to question and to use critical thinking skills in a respectful way. Maybe because they have a lot of learning which has come together, still combined with an innocence and openness to everything. :This curriculum development is impacting positively on the	

	growth and development of our children. Question from Leanne to parents about Educa and RE "Love it." "So great to see them working" Discussion about the progression - moving into deeper thinking for the older children.	
Prioritising to take action	We were told in our review that we are leading in curriculum and could be providing leadership to other schools when the new curriculum comes in. We are committed to providing authentic RE learning and this year we are waiting for the new curriculum.	
Monitoring and evaluating impact	As long as continuing to have decent conversations with children and embrace questioning. Continue quality conversations. We will consider the next assessment as to what it adds to depth of knowledge.
